Godelieve de Bree is internist (consultant) internal medicine with subspecialty infectious disease and is clinical principal investigator for translational HIV studies in the Amsterdam University Medical Center. Since 2012 she is affiliated at the Amsterdam Institute for Global Health and Development and the Academic Medical Center (AMC) in Amsterdam. The core of her clinical work involves general infectious diseases and clinical immunology, specifically primary immune deficiencies. As principal investigator she is leading the clinical HIV infection studies in the AMC, including studies on vaccination and virus-host interactions in acute HIV infection. Furthermore, she leads the efforts of the HIV Transmission Elimination AMsterdam (H-TEAM) initiative aiming at improving prognosis of HIV infected individuals and reducing HIV transmission in Amsterdam.
