## The Representative Studies Rubric (RSR): 12 Steps to Address Underrepresentation in HIV Clinical Research



## **Background & Methods**

Underrepresented populations suffer the consequences of exclusion from research.

The Legacy Project designed and applied a 12-item questionnaire (the RSR) to assess 47 HIV clinical research protocols for inclusiveness in the following categories: **Age**, **Ethnicity**, **Gender**, **Drug use**, **Pregnancy**, **Race**, and **Sex assigned at birth**.

A simple screening tool helps identify and rectify components of HIV research protocols that unnecessarily exclude underrepresented populations.



## Next Steps

Implement the RSR proactively as a protocol development tool to ensure representative study populations.
